- A Public Hearing was conducted to inform the general public of the condition of the properties owned by Joe and Anita Matzker at 107-C Lane Street and Willard Batton located at 405 Corrigan Street, which were declared to be dangerous buildings and a nuisance detrimental to the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Piedmont pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 505 of the Piedmont City Code ON June 19, 2020. The property at 107-C Lane has been cleaned up and repaired within the thirty day period. Willard Batton's property located at 405 Corrigan is for sale. If the sale isn't completed by the dead line, Mr. Batton has hired Kent Elrod to demolish and removed the dangerous buildings. No votes or motions were made on this issue. There were no questions.
