- The Piedmont City Council met in Special Session on March 24, 2021 at Piedmont City Hall. Those in attendance were as follows: Alderman Kyle Allen, Alderman Brian Tutterrow, Alderwoman Karen Townsend, City Attorney Bob Ramshur, and City Clerk Tammy Thurman. Mayor Pro-tem Scot Tucker presided over the meeting.

1. Mayor Pro-tem Scot Tucker opened the meeting. There were no guests.

2. After discussing the bidding process for the mandatory trash service, and Chapter 230 SOLID WASTE of the Piedmont City Code, Mayor Pro-tem Scot Tucker requested that the council consider tabling this issue to see if the Police Department will start writing tickets to those without trash service.

A motion was made by Alderwoman Townsend and seconded by Alderman Allen to table the bidding process of the mandatory trash service for two months. The motion carried.

3. Mayor Pro-tem Tucker requested that the council consider postponing the water/sewer rate increase which would take effect this month for a few months due to the water outage and boil water notice which has lasted 14 days.

Alderman Allen made the motion, seconded by Alderwoman Townsend to postpone increasing the water/sewer rates due to the water outage for 11 days and boil water notice for fourteen days until the water/sewer bills that will be due June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021. The motion carried.
