Ordinance #2017-02

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE HANDLING
OF CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTIONS
AND ESTABLISHING A METHOD FOR ACCOUNTING AND DEPOSITING
SUCH FUNDS TO THE CITY COLLECTOR**

WHEREAS, monies are paid from time to time to the City of Piedmont, representing charitable contributions; and

WHEREAS, a method is to be prescribed for the depositing and expenditure of such sums contributed to the City of Piedmont;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. From time to time third parties make monetary contributions to the City of Piedmont;
2. The City Collector shall maintain an Fund to be known as the Donations Fund;
3. Such monies that are contributed shall be delivered to the City Collector for deposit to the Donation Fund;
4. Such monies that are in the Donation Fund may be expended as directed by the Board of Aldermen or any purpose, to include Law Enforcement;
5. The City Clerk shall then issue checks drawn upon the City's Donation Fund, as the Board of Aldermen may approve;
6. Both the City Clerk and the City Collector shall maintain records of all monies received and expended in connection with maintenance of the City's Donation Fund.
