LOCAL USE TAX QUESTION

Shall the City of Piedmont, Missouri impose a local use tax at the same rate as the total local sales tax rate, currently two and fifty one hundredths percent (2.5%), provided that if the local sales tax rate is reduced or raised by voter approval, the local use tax rate shall also be reduced or raised by the same action? This is to help replace revenue lost due to a major retailer leaving the city. A use tax return shall not be required to be filed by persons whose purchases from out-of-state vendors do not exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) in any calendar year.
